If you are interested in presenting an *oral presentation* or a *poster*, please submit an abstract of no more than 300 words in .pdf format to [ucd.langsymposium@gmail.com](mailto:ucd.langsymposium@gmail.com). The file should not include any identifying information. In the body of the email please include your name, academic affiliation, year in the program, title of the paper, and whether you wish to present an oral presentation, a poster, or either. Please include "UCD Symposium on Language Research 2017" in the subject field. Oral presentations are limited to 15 minutes, plus an additional five minutes for questions. Posters must adhere to a dimension of 48 inches tall by 36 inches wide.

Abstract submissions submitted after the first deadline (March 31<sup>st</sup>, 11:59 PM) will not be considered for the Award for Most Innovative Research.
